Model of Ecouragement: Acts portrays Barnabas as a good man

and an apostle. His character and integrity earned him the nickname "Son of Encouragement." He supported fellow believers, championed their potential, and faced persecution for the sake of Christ. Bridge Builder: Barnabas bridged the gap between Jewish and Gentile believers. He worked alongside the apostle Paul, forming a dynamic partnership that enhanced their ministry's outreach and impact. His ability to foster unity among diverse followers was crucial for the early church. **Leadership in Antioch**: Barnabas played a key role in establishing the church in Antioch. He encouraged believers to remain true to the Lord and brought Paul to Antioch, where they worked together in ministry. Additionally, Barnabas participated in providing aid to the church in Jerusalem during a famine.
