The story of Esther is rich with principles that Christians can apply in sharing their faith and living sacrificially for others. Here are three key principles learned from Esther's courageousness:

1. Courage in the Face of Fear

Esther's willingness to approach King Ahasuerus, knowing it could cost her life, teaches the importance of courage. She faced her fear and took a stand for her people. Christians can learn from Esther to be bold in sharing their faith and standing up for what is right, even when it involves personal risk. This principle is echoed in 2 Timothy 1:7, which says, "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."

2. Selflessness and Sacrifice

Esther's actions were driven by a deep sense of responsibility and love for her people. She was willing to risk her own safety for the benefit of others.

This sacrificial attitude is central to the Christian faith, as demonstrated by Jesus' ultimate sacrifice.



Christians are called to live selflessly, putting the needs of others before their own, as stated in Philippians 2:3-4, "Do nothing out of selfish ambition

or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others."

3. Dependence on God and Community

Before approaching the king, Esther asked the Jewish community to fast and pray for her. This reliance on God and the support of her community underscores the importance of prayer and solidarity. Christians can draw strength and guidance from God and their faith community when facing challenging situations.

By embracing these principles, Christians can be inspired to share their faith and live sacrificially just as Esther did.
