Re-read 1 John 4:7-21. Try comparing two different translations.

Was there anything surprising or new that you learned from the sermon? What was most meaningful or significant for you? Why?

When was the first time you truly internalized God's love for you? Did an event trigger this? Describe what happened

How have you come to know that God loves you (verse 16)? What difference has this made in your life?

How does the world define love? How does the Bible/God define love? (vss. 9-10) What historical event proved this?

Why are we commanded to love others? (vs. 11) Why else? Genesis 1:26

What does our love for others prove (give evidence of)? 1 John 3:14

What do 1 Timothy 1:17 & Colossians 1:15 teach us about God & Jesus? Explain your answer through the lens of verse 12 of our passage

Discuss the following image/illustration:

God's love experienced in us ----> God's love experienced through us!

What is one very powerful result of knowing God that we learn from verse 16 of our passage? How has this been true in your life?

How was this knowledge of God lacking in Adam & Eve in the Garden of Eden?

What does verse 17 of our passage teach us?

Meditate upon the Apostle Paul's words in Ephesians 3:17-19. Pray that God would use your knowledge and love of Him to <u>transform</u> you into His image!
