Going Deeper

Re-read Matthew 25:1-30. Try comparing two different translations. Take some time as a group discussing your observations.

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11. Talk about the difference between Christ's Second Coming catching us like a thief-in-the-night or like a fiancé returning unannounced to claim his bride!

There are 2 stories/parables in our passage. What elements do both have in common? Are there differences? Who are the people: *the bridegroom*, *the virgins*, *the servants*, *the master*... What does each represent?

What aspects of Jewish Wedding Culture do we find in the first story? How is this similar to what will happen at Christ's Second Coming?

How is the theme of ownership reflected in each of the stories? Explain. What's our part in the salvation process? Read Luke 13:24-27 & Revelation 3:7-8.

In your opinion, what does it mean to enter into our Master's joy? How can we do this?

Application

How can you prepare yourself this week for Christ's Return? What does it mean for you to *stay awake*, *be alert/watchful?*

Initial Insights

There's a financial term called **R. O. I.** which stands for "return on investment." Today's passage is really about **R. O. J.** - "return on joy!"
