Read Hebrews 13:10-14. What does it mean for us *to go out* to meet Jesus? Read Exodus 33:7-11 for context.

What are some practical ways that we can help bear/carry people's shame (both within the church & without)?

What was Jesus's <u>motivation</u> in <u>Hebrews 12:1-2</u>? What can we learn from His example?

Read Micah 2:12-13. What encouragement does this passage
