 - Which error do you think people most often fall into, and why?
 - Which error do you most often fall into?
2. Read 1 Peter 5:6–11 and Ephesians 6:10–18.
 - What similarities do you notice in these passages?
 - What differences?
 - What common calls to action do you see?
3. On Sunday we talked about Satan’s schemes (methodeia) in verse 11.
 - Have you noticed certain methods or tactics that Satan seems to use repeatedly?
 - From what you have witnessed, what have been some of the greatest causes of spiritual collapse in people?
4. Where do you see the devil’s schemes being played out in today’s society?
5. List and review the full armor of God.
 - How does each piece help us “make our stand”?
 - Which pieces come more naturally for you?
 - Which ones are harder to put on?
6. From tonight’s reading and discussion, what truth—if you really held onto it—would most help you live out your faith this week?
